Dr Kwame Adu-Poku graduated from the KNUST Medical School, Kumasi, Ghana, obtaining BSc (Human Biology) in 1986 and MB ChB in 1989. He undertook his postgraduate diploma in clinical pathology training at the Royal Postgraduate Medical School, Hammersmith Hospital, London from 1994 to 1996. In 1996, he returned to Ghana and was appointed a lecturer in pathology at KNUST Medical School (June 1996 – June 1998).

Dr Adu-Poku moved back to the UK in July 1998, and was appointed an honorary registrar in histopathology at Royal Liverpool University Hospital. He became a specialist registrar in the southwest deanery, undertaking postgraduate training from 2001 to 2005 – rotating in Exeter, Plymouth and Bristol.

He was later appointed as a locum consultant in histopathology at Basildon University Hospital where he developed an interest in pulmonary and gynaecological pathology. He obtained the FRCPath in 2007, and joined Bedford Hospital as a consultant histopathologist in May 2009.
