Dr Elmarimi qualified in medicine in Libya in 1993, and obtained MRCP in 2003, after which he trained in general and geriatric medicine in London and Kent. He was awarded the Stroke Association clinical fellowship in stroke medicine at Kings College London.

Dr Elmarimi trained in stroke medicine at Guy's and St Thomas Hospital, London. After finishing his research fellowship and higher specialist training, he worked as a locum consultant stroke physician at Maidstone Hospital, where he helped to establish a modern acute stroke unit, and played a major part in the set up and running of stroke thrombolysis service.

He joined Bedford Hospital in March 2009.

Dr Elmarimi's main interest is the acute and hyperacute management of stroke, and he has a special research interest in the pathology of stroke in diabetic patients and its effects on outcome.
