Dr Saunders graduated from the Royal Free Hospital in 1969, being awarded his MRCP in 1973. The majority of his gastrointestinal training was undertaken in Dundee, with one year spent at the Rigshospitalet, Copenhagen, focussing on liver disease. He completed his MD qualification in 1980 on the subject of pancreatic insufficiency & pancreatic enzymes.

Appointed at Bedford Hospital as a physician & gastroenterologist in 1980, Dr Saunders became a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians in 1989. He has served on the District Health Authority and was clinical tutor before the hospital became a Trust. Since then he has been clinical director of medicine more than once and medical director 1999-2002. Dr Saunders is the longest serving chair of the Drugs & Therapeutics committee.
