Dr Ihab El Madhoun graduated from Al Arab Medical University in Libya in 1997 with honour degree. He then took his first job as SHO in emergency medicine in Hamad Medical Corporation in Qatar where he started his postgraduate training. Dr El Madhoun moved to UK in 2001 where he started his medical rotation in medicine. He gained his MRCP (UK) in 2002 while working in James Cook University Hospital in Middlesbrough. In 2003 he started his higher medical training in renal medicine in St James's University Hospital, Leeds. During his rotation, he trained in three other renal units in Yorkshire between Bradford, Hull and York.

Dr El Madhoun completed his higher training in 2008 with dual accreditation (CCT) in renal and general medicine. He joined the renal team as consultant in Bradford Royal Infirmary and St Luke's Hospitals in January 2009 for almost a year before moving to join the renal team in Salford Royal University Teaching Hospital. In 2009, Dr El Madhoun completed a Postgraduate Diploma in health research from the University of Leeds.

In September 2010, Dr El Madhoun joined Bedford Hospital as a consultant in acute and renal medicine. He is the first nephrologist to be employed directly by Bedford Hospital and will contribute in initiating local renal services. Dr El Madhoun is interested in acute kidney injuries and risk reduction in chronic kidney diseases.
