Mrs Melanie Hingorani obtained her BA in physiology and premedical training at St John's College, Oxford (1986) and her clinical training at Guy's Hospital, London. Mrs Hingorani did her basic ophthalmic surgical training in various London hospitals, this was followed by a two and a half year combined basic science research and clinical fellowship in corneal and anterior segment disease at Moorfields Eye Hospital and the Institute of Ophthalmology, leading to the award of an MD for her doctoral thesis "The immunopathogenesis and treatment of chronic ocular allergic eye disease".

Following this, Mrs Hingorani completed her higher surgical training at Moorfields and the Western Eye Hospital and then undertook two advanced training fellowships at Moorfields, one in paediatrics and strabismus with Mr John Lee and Prof Tony Moore, and one in corneal, cataract and anterior segment disease with Mr Bruce Allan and Mr John Dart.

Mrs Hingorani now works as a consultant ophthalmic surgeon at Moorfields at Bedford Hospital. Her areas of special interest are paediatrics and strabismus/ocular motility and she has published extensively in many aspects of ophthalmology, particularly paediatric eye disease, aniridia and allergic eye disease. Mrs Hingorani also has interests in shared care with community optometrists for common eye conditions and botulinum toxin use for ocular motility problems.
