Dr Yaqub Latoo is the lead consultant anaesthetist in obstetrics anaesthesia and clinical governance. He graduated from India in 1990 and completed his rotational SHO training in anaesthesia and medicine including one year as a postgraduate MD student in anaesthesia.

Dr Latoo moved to the UK in 1994 for further training in anaesthesia and intensive care medicine, going on to pass his final FRCA in 2000. He has also completed specialist training at University College London Hospital, Imperial School of Anaesthesia, Great Ormond Street Hospital and Cambridge University Hospital. This training took him through a broad spectrum of specialties.

Dr Latoo, left his post as senior specialist registrar in anaesthesia and intensive care medicine at The Heart Hospital London to join Bedford Hospital NHS Trust in January 2005. He provides anaesthesia and critical care for all specialties at the hospital and has a special interest in obstetrics, paediatrics, trauma and orthopedics, ear, nose and throat, gynaecology and general surgical patients.

Aside from his role as a consultant, Dr Latoo is also actively involved in teaching junior doctors and medical students. He is the secretary of the senior medical staff committee at the Trust and represents his division on a range of committees and forums. He is also the medical editor of British Journal of Medical Practitioners www.bjmp.org and an executive member of British Asian Medical Association.
