Mr Lobo qualified in medicine from Goa Medical College, Goa, India in 1992. He also completed his junior residency and part of the senior residency programme in ophthalmology there.

Subsequently, Mr Lobo underwent basic specialist training in ophthalmology in a number of centres in Huddersfield and Colchester and completed higher specialist training at South Thames Rotation of the London Deanery for Ophthalmology. In between, he undertook a 2 year clinical and laboratory research fellowship at Moorfields Eye Hospital and the Institute of Ophthalmology, specialising in uveitis and intraocular lymphoma.

After higher training, advanced subspecialty fellowships were undertaken in medical retina. Mr Lobo commenced as a locum consultant ophthalmologist with an interest in medical retina at the Barts and The London NHS Trust, followed by a term as locum consultant ophthalmologist at Moorfields @ Bedford and Hinchingsbrooke NHS Trust.

He has been appointed to a substantive post as a consultant ophthalmologist specialising in medical retina at Moorfields @ Bedford and Hinchingsbrooke NHS Trust's eye unit at Huntingdon since December 2008 and is clinical lead for Moorfields @ Bedford eye unit.

He is the clinical lead for the Bedfordshire Diabetic Retinopathy Screening Service providing services to Bedfordshire, Luton and Dunstable regions.
