Dr David Niblett graduated from University College London in 1977, becoming a Fellow of the Royal College of Anaesthetists in 1982. He became anaesthetic SHO at Nottingham University Hospitals in 1978, taking time out to lecture in anatomy at Stanford University, California in 1980. On his return to the UK, Dr Niblett became a registrar in anaesthesia and critical care at the Royal Free Hospital, moving on to become senior registrar at Oxford Hospitals in 1982. In 1986 he joined Bedford Hospital as a consultant in critical care and anaesthesia.

His areas of interest/specialty are critical care and anaesthesia. Dr Niblett has been actively involved in research (both basic sciences and clinical) since 1980. He has a very active research program in the critical care complex at Bedford Hospital, being involved in several important multicentre trials as well as various research projects with his critical care colleagues.

He is a Director of ATLS (Trauma Care) courses at the hospital as well as instructing on other courses. In addition, Dr Niblett is the medical patient safety lead for Bedford Hospital. He also has a major interest in sports medicine as medical officer for Bedford Blues RFC and the East Midlands RFU.
