Mr Paul Tisi qualified from The Medical College of Saint Bartholomew's Hospital (University of London), 1988 and began his registrar training in 1992 in the Wessex region which is where he first became interested in vascular surgery. Mr Tisi undertook a two year period of research in Southampton which led to a Master of Surgery higher degree (Assessment and Treatment of Intermittent Claudication) and undertook his specialist vascular training in Chichester, Southampton University Hospitals, Portsmouth and Bournemouth Hospitals, obtaining his CCST in 2000.

Mr Tisi was appointed as consultant vascular and general surgeon at Bedford Hospital in 2001, also undertaking some sessions at Luton & Dunstable Hospital on an outreach basis. He has significant involvement in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and has become a Fellow of the Higher Education Academy.

In addition to this Mr Tisi is also Editor, Cochrane Collaborative Review Group on Peripheral Vascular Diseases; Contributor to BMJ Clinical Evidence (Varicose Veins); Reviewer for the European Journal of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery and VASA; Undergraduate Specialty Tutor for Surgery; Associate Medical Director for Surgery at Bedford Hospital.

Mr Tisi's clinical interests include:

- All aspects of vascular surgery, including ;
 - Venous surgery: varicose veins (surgery, ultrasound-guided foam sclerotherapy, radiofrequency ablation [VNUS closure]), leg ulcers, wound healing, duplex scanning;
 - Arterial surgery: peripheral vascular disease, carotid artery disease, aortic and peripheral aneurysms;
 - Lymphatic surgery: lymphoedema;
- Minor/intermediate general surgery (eg hernias, skin lesions).
