What am I allergic to?

You have been found to be allergic to **Octyl Gallate**.

What is Octyl Gallate?

Octyl Gallate is an antioxidant for use in cosmetic and pharmaceutical products, and in food products such as margarine and peanut butter where it may be listed as **E311**.

What must I avoid?

You should avoid any product which lists **octyl gallate** as an ingredient, and avoid any foods which contain **E311**.

Where can Octyl Gallate be found?

Octyl Gallate can be found in the following products; always check the label:

- Cosmetics
- Soaps
- Shampoos
- Shaving soaps
- Skin lotions
- Deodorants
- Margarines
- Peanut Butters
- Other foods
