

Cautery is used to remove unwanted areas of tissue which may be causing you problems or giving you unpleasant symptoms.

Cryocautery is a freezing method usually used on the cervix.

Following treatment you may feel some discomfort like a period pain. You will experience a heavy watery vaginal discharge for several days. This is normal and you may need to wear sanitary towels. During this time, or if you have a period within two weeks of treatment, do not use tampons.

- You may have some bleeding about 10 days after the treatment.
- Do not have sexual intercourse for two weeks following treatment.
- You may bath and shower as normal and you may continue to work and activities as normal.
