Today you have had:

- Cervical swabs
- Cervical smear
- Cervical polyp
- Endometrial biopsy

taken at the colposcopy clinic.

When will I get my results?

You should receive the results in approximately four weeks' time.

Aftercare

You may get discoloured discharge if the polyp site has been cauterised with Monsel's paste.

You may get some silvery black discharge if the polyp site has been cauterised using Silver Nitrate. This will stain your underwear and you are advised to use pads.

You may also have some spotting or light bleeding for a few days. You should not have intercourse until 48 hours after the spotting has finished.
