Dr Anwar Rashid graduated from Bangalore Medical College, Bangalore University, India in 1996 and completed his MD in Anaesthetics from Gujarat University, Ahmedabad, India in 2002.

After coming to UK in 2004, Dr Rashid completed basic and advanced anaesthetic training from Kent-Surrey & Sussex (KSS) deanery and Oxford deanery rotating through East Surrey Hospital, Conquest Hospital, Royal Berkshire Hospital, Milton Keynes Hospital and Oxford University Hospitals. He was appointed as a Consultant Anaesthetist in Bedford Hospital in 2012.
